DRAFT MINUTES OF THE MOOR MONKTON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD REMOTELY ON WEDNESDAY 15TH JULY 2020

- **20.038** All Parish Councillors being present, the only apology received was from District Cllr Andy Paraskos

The question of the Asset Register was discussed and the layout to be slightly changed in line with YLCA's suggested format. The ownership of a Sycamore Tree in the village was questioned. *Action Point: Cllr Gibbs to inspect and report back.*

- (a) (19.039) A59 Traffic Calming Measures An update on the revised layout plan for the junction to be provided at a later date.
- (b) (19.039) Cllr Paraskos has arranged for new replacement (crossroads and double bend slow down) signs which have now been installed. Also Cllr Paraskos has arranged with NYCC for improved lighting to be installed at the end of Church Lane to provide an improved spread of light over the crossroads. Cllr Paraskos has asked NYCC to provide MMPC with a cost of re-installing the 40mph sign on the A59 western approach to MM.

20.045 (19.088) Lancaster Bomber Memorial Stone – Update

- The latest correspondence was received on 15th July from the Clerk at Edlington Town Council, who had been taken ill and was in hospital and as a consequence their TC meeting on 14th July had been postponed. MMPC had received correspondence from and responded to an Edlington resident. A Moor Monkton resident who is an aviation historian and enthusiast has undertaken independent research and concluded that W4904 did crash at Cockhill, Moor Monkton.
- Date for the re-dedication service of the plaque this is to be confirmed at a later date.
