### DRAFT MINUTES OF THE MOOR MONKTON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD REMOTELY ON WEDNESDAY 16TH SEPTEMBER 2020

**20.062 Update on progress with Highways.**

(a) (19.039) Cllr Paraskos has confirmed that 40mph mandatory road signs can be installed on both the western and eastern approaches of the A59 at Moor Monkton. There will also be improved lighting at the crossroads in MM. NYCC are however seeking a contribution of £500 from MMPC.

**(b) Upgrading of the A1 / A59 junction**

Following an enquiry by a resident of MM, advice was received from Highways, England, on the plans in place to ensure smooth running of the traffic during the upgrading work.

**20.066 Request from Nether Poppleton Parish Council regarding the re-instatement of footpath at Scally Moor Farm.**

It was decided that MMPC support the re-instatement of a footpath at Scally Moor Farm but do not suggest which route it should take and the decision should be left to the Secretary of State to decide in December.

**20.067 District and County Councillor's comments.**

Cllr Myatt was unable to attend but gave an update on the District Plan for Development (DPD) for the new settlement which will commence next month and Councils and local representatives are invited to take part. There will be a public consultation on the preferred locality for the new settlement within the broad location of the Hammertons and Cattal, now proposing 4000 new homes.

Cllr Paraskos has updated us on the A59 issues.
