APPLICATION NO: 6.115.142.B.FUL 21/00713/FUL

PROPOSAL: Erection of menage on land for the exercising of dogs and horses.

LOCATION: Laburnum Croft Church Lane Moor Monkton York North
 Yorkshire YO26 8JA

After a full and frank discussion including participation of members of the public it was decided to object to the planning application for the following reasons

- Drainage issues on the surrounding area which is already prone to flooding
- Potential change of usage from agricultural land
- The location is unsuitable for a commercial venture and if approved, should be restricted to applicants own dogs and horses
- Restriction should also be to the use in daylight hours so as to avoid light pollution to neighbouring properties

- Significant disruption to the village during construction
- Reported additional dogs being trained on the premises already (in addition to the 6 who are resident) causing:
 - Additional noise
 - Additional traffic obstructing the existing small cul-de-sac
 - Danger of traffic to young children

It was also agreed to ask for an extension of the deadline for objections to allow additional time for postal objections to be sent
