There have recently been a spate accidents close to the junction. The Parish Council have currently enlisted the help of Nigel Adams, MP in an attempt to introduce speed restrictions.
- It was suggested by a Parishioner, that a Hedgehog sign should be put on Church Lane to make people aware of Hedgehogs as there had been at least 7 hedgehogs that had been killed.
